No. 1678. Your telegram of September 50th,
No. 1527, offer of firemen. United Kingdom Government
have asked me to say that they warmly welcome generous
suggestion of Canadian Government and are most anxious
to take advantage of this. It is not thought immediate
action is necessary, as authorities here are now receiving
re-enforcements from trained firemen in military forces.
It is suggested that detailed arrangements should be
discussed between this office and Home Office, and these
discussions are being entered into at once and cover
points mentioned in last sentence of your telegram under
reference.
