and credit within nation, B. of C. also has
important international functions to perform;
It is, in a sense, the guardian of the nation's financial relations
with other countries;

Possesses knowledge and authority to speak for Canada at intermational conferences on questions of finance;

Social Aspects of Central Banks

The Central Bank, while a commercial institution of which the

functions are purely financial, acquires a

social aspect by virtue of its relationship to

the community as a whole -

in the mature of a public trust;

Thus the interests and responsibilities of Central Bank transcend private interests and become a matter of concern to the State;

The Central Bank is, in a sense, the point at which private
financial enterprise and public administration
moet;

Government's relation to Contral Bank:
