THE CANADIAN NORTH-WEST

HOMESTEAD

REGULATIONS

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the Northwest Territories, excepting 8 and 26, which has not been home-scaded, or reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or for other pur-poses, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

ENTRY.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District

In which the land to be taken is stunte, or if the homestcader desires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg, or the Local Agent for the District in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for him. A fee entry. of \$10 is charged for a homestead

HOMESTEAD DUTIES.

A settler who has been granted at entry for a homestead is required by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amendments thereto, to perform the conditions connected therewith, under one of the following plans:

(I) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming hard owned by him in the vicinity of his household, the requirements of this Act as for residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

A settler who avails himself of the provisions of Clauses (2) (3) or 4) must cultivate 20 acres of his homestead, or substitute 20 head to know stock, with buildings for their accommedation, and have besides 80 acres substantially fenced.
