

At the annual meeting of the American At the annual meeting of the American Cotswold Registry Association, held in Chicago, it was decided that the regular appropriation to all state fairs and the Toronto exhibition be continued, and that the special prizes offered by the Association to the International Live-Stock Exposition be restricted to the sheep bred in North America. The receipts for the year amounted to \$2,769.60. The Association has a balance on hand of \$4,080.95. J. D. Brien, of Ridgetown, Ontario, is a director of this association.

An interesting survey of Orange Township, Iowa, was completed recently and the Christian Herald shows the results to be as follows: "The survey developed that of the 142 farm homes in the township all have newspapers and magazines; 125 have libraries, with an average of 100 volumes; 132 have telephones; 80 have pianos; 79 have automobilies; 76 have vacuum cleaners, 72 have furnace heat; 68 have powerwashers; 63 have electric light; 57 have running water and 47 have bathrooms."
