 Cincinnati, Ohio, Oct. 9.—What was said to be the largest collection ever taken up on plates by any church in America; an interpretation by the house of bishops on the "open pulpit" subject and refusal to change the name of the church, were among the most important features of the triennial convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in session here yesterday. While the convention was in session, a communion service was being held in Christ Church, where the donations were being received for the general missionary fund. At the conclusion it was announced that the collection was \$242,110.83.
