- No. 1.—Despatch from the Secretary of State for the Colonies to His Excellency the Governor, directing that Proceedings of the Legislature be transmitted to his Lordship, in duplicate, carried down to the latest period preceding the departure of the Packet.—23d March, 1849
- 2.—Ditto, transmitting a Correspondence relative to a revised Table of Fees for the Vice Admiralty Court, &c.—11th May, 1849.
- 3.—Ditto, acknowledging receipt of a Despatch enclosing an Address from the House of Assembly on the subject of the future tenure of office.—14th May, 1849.
