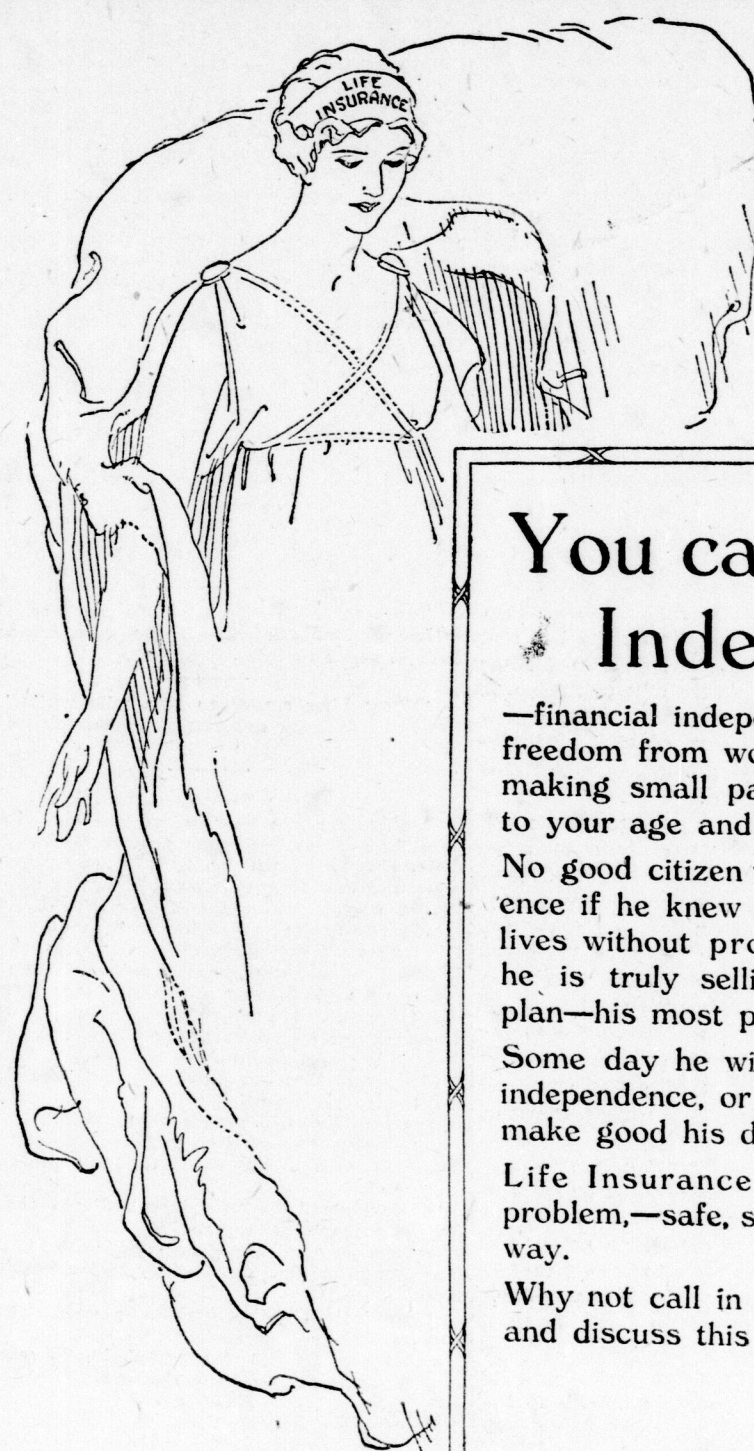

GATES OF PENITENTIARY CLOSE UPON PETER SMITH

Former Provincial Treasurer Is Now Prisoner K-831 at Portsmouth.

SAYS HE IS POOR

Declares Aemilius Jarvis Should Pay Fine Imposed by Court.

Canadian Press Despatch. Kingston, Nov. 13.—Closing a unique chapter in the public life of the province of Ontario, the walls of Portsmouth penitentiary today held in punitive grip, in common with hundreds of other wrong-doers and sinners against society, Peter Smith, one-time provincial treasurer of Ontario, who began his sentence of three years' imprisonment for conspiracy to defraud the province.

One hour after he reached the prison he was prisoner K-831; he had undergone the regular routine of every criminal who enters the portals of the prison, which included a bath, a close haircut and the donning of a suit of drab gray with his number on the back of the coat. He was assigned to his cell, but the work which he will perform has not yet been decided. It is thought, however, that he will get clerical duty or agricultural work.

Wife Accompanies.
Smith arrived at the prison about one o'clock this afternoon from Toronto and was escorted by Governor Major Basher of Toronto jail. During his trip he appeared cheerful and carried on a conversation with newspapermen and his wife, who accompanied him to Kingston, and followed the automobile which carried him to the prison gates which she saw close upon him. Mrs. Smith drove to a hotel afterwards where she waited for the first train which took her west to her home in Stratford.

The former provincial treasurer was not handcuffed when he stepped off the train at Kingston. He and Major Basher hurried to a waiting automobile some hundred feet from the station, but the prisoner was identified by a small crowd of people who stood nearby. With the evident purpose of avoiding publicity Major Basher directed the driver of the motor car to proceed to the penitentiary by way of the back streets and to keep from the main thoroughfare of the city. After a final leave-taking of his wife at the prison gates, Smith was escorted to the office of the warden and immediately prepared for the serving of his sentence.

VICTORIA PREMIER HAS TENDERED RESIGNATION

Associated Press Despatch. Melbourne, Victoria, Nov. 13.—The Labor premier of Victoria, G. M. Prendergast, resigned office today as a result of the defeat of his government in parliament yesterday on a no-confidence vote and the refusal of the governor, the Earl of Strathmore, to accede to his request for parliamentary dissolution. Following yesterday's defeat of the Labor government, which was by a vote of 34 to 28, the parliament adjourned until Nov. 18. The Labor ministry took office last June.

ROAD FOREMAN KILLED WHEN STRUCK BY AUTO

Guelph, Nov. 13.—Wesley Black, 61 years old, road foreman on the Guelph radial railway, was instantly killed shortly before noon today when an automobile driven by Miss Hazel Young, a professional nurse, daughter of David Young, principal of the Guelph public schools, struck him while he was welding rails on the York road track.

PREMIER WANTS UNIFORM VERSION OF "O CANADA"

Canadian Press Despatch. Ottawa, Nov. 13.—Speaking at the banquet given to Hon. "Hal" McGavin here last night, Premier Mackenzie King referred to the singing of "O Canada" at the different gatherings on his recent tour throughout Canada. He noted many different versions.

Premier King said that there should be one verse that would be accepted by all. He suggested that parliament, either by resolution or in some other way, might appoint somebody to choose one stanza of "O Canada" on which all would be agreed and which could be sung from one end of Canada to the other.

VIENNA RAILWAYS AGAIN RUN AFTER LENGTHY STRIKE

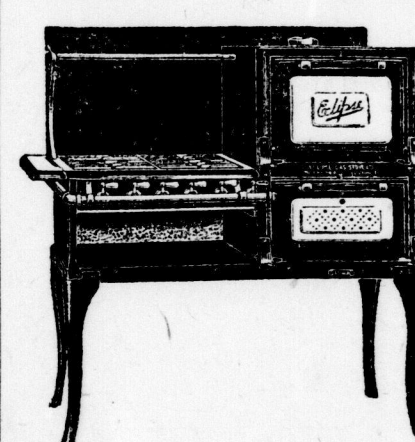

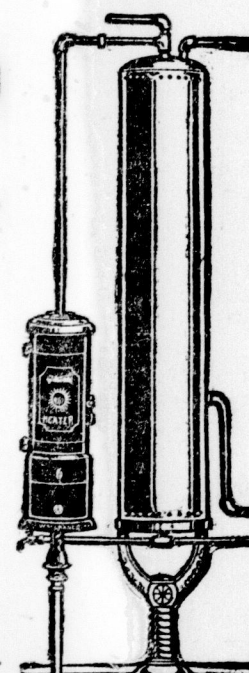
