



THE following BILCS will be introduced at the next Session of the Legislature:

A BILL to amend Sect 68 Chapter 100, Consolidated Statutes, providing that where the Real Estate of any Resident or Non-Resident is reduced by the Valuators, the same reduction shall be made in the valuation of the Parish, and further amending the said Chapter by giving the County of York the option to make valuation when they may deem proper.

A BILL to amend Section 49 of Cap. 65 of the Consolidated Statues "of Schools," by changing the time for holding the Annual School Meeting from second Thursday in Jan-uary to the first Thursday in September.

A BILL to amend Cap. 110 of the Consolidated Statutes relating to Fences, Trespasses, and Pounds; by making the boundaries of the roads and shores of the river and intervales in districts in which cattle are prohibited from running at large; lawful fences and enclosures.
