


## Ontario: Apples in the West Planett & Savage, Lethbridge, Alberta

way to pack apples to handle to advantage is in boxes with each individual apple wrapped in paper and the box paper lined

We have received cars of apples from a shipper in the State of Washington who has frequently offered us one hundred dollars if we could find one apple in the whole carload with a worm-hole. When we take into consideration this offer, we be lieve there are very few apple growers a shippers in Ontario who would be prepared to make the same offer.

The fruit trees in Washington and the States generally are far better taken can of than in Eastern Canada, and we believe if the Ontario growers and shippen intend to retain the western market, the have got to wake up and use facilitie necessary for keeping their fruit clean and free from defects.
