MAIL BAGS.

Sealed Tenders addressed to the Postmaster General (For Printing and Supply Branch), and marked "Tender for Mail Bags," will be received at Ottawa until twelve o'clock, noon, on MONDAY, the sun NOVEMBER, 1885, for the supply of the Post Office Department of Canada with such Cotton Duck, Jute and Leather Mail Bags as may from time to time be required for the Postal Service of the Dominion.

Samples of the Bags to be furnished may be seen at the Post Offices at Halifast. N. Sa. St. John, N. B. Charlottetown, P.E.I., Quebic, Montreal, Ottawa, Toronto, London, Winnipeg, Man., Victoria, B.C., or at the Post Office Department at Ottawa.

The Bags-supplied, both as regards material and manufactive, to be fully equal to the samples, and to be delivered from time to time in such quantities as may be required at Ottawa.

The contract, if satisfactorily executed, shall continue in force for the term of four years, provided always the workmanship and material be satisfactory to the Postmaster-General.

Each tender to state the price asked per bag in the form and manner prescribed by the form of tender, and to be accompanied by the satisfactory to the Tender being accepted the contract shall be duty executed by the pasty thuering for the price demanded. 



We call attention particularly to the construction of FIRE POT. It will be noticed by an examination of the engravings that between the fire and the iron containing the water there is a lining of brick, by the use of which we obtain a perfectly bright fire on the outer edge as well as in the centre, which is the great defect in all other Boilers.

HEATING SURFACE.

On examining the engravings it will be observed that the products of combustion, gases, heat, etc., after leaving the fire pot section are carried through a number of tubes into an expansion chamber, where, striking the bottom of the next section above, they spread to find their exit through another series of tubes to another expansion chamber, where they are spread as before, thus striking successively the bottom surfaces of five sections before reaching the final exit at the pipe leading to the chimney flue.

It will be at once conceded that heat applied in this way is much more effective than though applied to the side surface of east or wrought iron pipe, a familiar illustration of this will be afforded by suggesting the relative value of fire applied to the bottom of a teakettle or to its side.
