

BREF JUICE.—Cut a pound of ten-der round, using only the lean, into inch pieces. Broil a minute or a min-ute and a half over a quick fire. ute and a half over a quick fire. Press the meat in a meat or lemon squeezer, having the dish which receives it warm, and set in hot water until all the juice is out of it. FRANKLIN CAKE .- Mix together : pint of molasses and half a pint of milk, in which cut up half a pound of butter. Warm just enough to melt the butter and stir in six ounces of brown sugar, adding three tablespoonsful of powdered cloves and a grated nutmeg. Beat seven eggs very light, and stir them gradually into the mixture, in turn with a pound and two ounces of sifted flour. Add the grated peel and the juice of two lemons. very hard. Put in buttered tins and bake in a moderate oven.

CORN CAKE OR BREAKFAST. Beat together one egg, two table-spoonsful of sugar, two of melted but-ter, one half teaspoonful salt, two teacer, one nair teaspoonin sait, two tea-cupsful cornmeat, one tablespoonful flour, one teaspoonful cream of tartar, mixed with the dry meal and flour, half teaspoonful soda and two teacupsful of sweet milk. Dissolve the soda in the milk and add last. Bake in a shallow tin pan about fifteen minutes in a wellneated oven.



MACAROON CUSTARDS.-Arrange two or three macaroons in each of a set of china custard cups; make a custard of a quart of milk and the yelks of six eggs, with sugar and a pinch of salt. Flavour with bitter almond, fill up the cups and bake, setting them in a dripping-pan half filled with water. When set, cover with a meringue made of the whites of the eggs with a cup of powered sugar, and bake lightly.


