He was unwearied in His journeyings over the mountains and through the valleys of Palestine to announce the good tidings. The shores of the rivers and streams heard His voice as well as the walls of the temple and the synagogues. He gave up His precious life to show how very much in earnest He was in His zeal.

If we are not called to work in the vast field of the apostolate, we can at least take as objects of our zeal our children, our parents, our servants, our masters, our friends; we may strive by our words and examples, or at least by our prayers, to make them love God more and more. If we do this earnestly, and in a spirit of faith, no matter what our station in life may be, we shall be apostles. It is to develope this spirit of zeal that the devotion to the Heart of Jesus is mainly directed. Let us love Him Who loved us so ardently, and we shall do all in our power to procure His glory and save the souls which He has redeemed.
