Mobilité des jeunes travailleurs

General

Young workers, who have been Quebec residents for at least one year and who have a firm employment offer in France, may be issued a temporary work permit. Workers must seek employment on their own.

Conditions for admission

Candidates must submit to l'Office Franco-Québécois pour la jeunesse (OFQJ):

- a letter with an employment offer from an employer in France (6 to 12 months' employment);

- proof of age (18 to 30 years);
- an application form supplied by l'Office Franco-Québécois pour la jeunesse.

Eligibility

To be eligible applicants must:

- be Alberta residents;
- have a minimum of one year of relevant experience;
- be 18 to 30 years old;
- have a good knowledge of English (essential); knowledge of Japanese is an asset.

Subsidy

The government of Alberta may subsidize the cost of travel upon completion of traineeship.

Work period

12 months' duration
