your party allegiance.

PAWLEY: I don't know where your impression is Elizabeth that there is a serious party problem here. As I indicated I think the party philosophically in its roots has had serious concerns about tarifs and we're not talking about the Auto Pact. The Auto Pact falls outside this entirely. Certainly the NDP has never supported the erecting of large tarifs in order to support vested interest groups.

GRAY: Premier Pawley thank you very much.

PAWLEY: Okay, good Elizabeth.

CBC: Manitoba premier Howard Pawley spoke to us from Winnipeg.
