THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THE COMPOSITION OF THE CANADIAN DELEGATION TO THE TENTH SESSION OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF THE UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION (UNESCO) WHICH WILL BE HELD AT THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE ORGANIZATION IN PARIS FROM NOVEMBER 4 TO DECEMBER 5, 1958.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE DELEGATION WILL BE DR. N.A.M. MACKENZIE, PRESIDENT OF THE CANADIAN NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR UNESCO, MEMBER OF THE CANADA COUNCIL AND PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BRITISH COLUMBIA.
