Director of Soldier Settlement to pay rates, taxes and assessments on lands not under contract of sale; and to enable the department to convey areas greater in extent than five acres for the purposes specified in section 29 of the Act

Resolution to be reported.

The said Resolution was reported, read the second time and concurred in.

Mr. Gordon then, by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. 100, An Act to amend the Soldier Settlement Act, which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The House resolved itself again into Committee of Supply.
