

GUIDE TO THE USER

This index is subject-preserved and chronological. Each entry is located by date; a list of dates may be found on the following page.

The index includes entries relating specifically to the news media as well as specific pronouncements under the names of newspaper publishers, journalists, those mentioned by name. The entries include chronologically following the entries last of the subjects based largely, The index also includes first.

All subject entries in the index are arranged chronologically, entries beginning to designation the following chronologically.

A subject will usually occur in a main heading followed by one or more sub-headings.
