FISH PLANT CLOSURES IN ATLANTIC COMMUNITIES—LABOUR ADJUSTMENT AID PACKAGE—COMPOSITION OF COMMUNITY FUTURES COMMITTEES IN NEWFOUNDLAND AND NOVA SCOTIA—REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

Hon. C. William Doody (Deputy Leader of the Government): Honourable senators, I have a delayed answer in response to a question asked in the Senate on January 23 last by the Honourable Senator Stewart respecting Employment and Immigration—Fish Plant Closures in Atlantic Communities—Labour Adjustment Aid Package—Composition of Community Futures Committees in Newfoundland and Nova Scotia—Request for Information

(The answer follows:)

1. The \$130-million short-term assistance package is a three-part initiative.

—First, laid off workers will be helped through the Industrial Adjustment Service, the Unemployment Insurance Program, special response measures, training, relocation and Community Futures;

—Second, in cooperation with the provinces, laid off workers will be helped through the Program for Older Worker Adjustment;

—Third, communities will be helped to diversify their economies through a Community Development Fund administered by the Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency (ACOA).
