I am instructed by the Board of Governors of McGill University to acknowledge your letter of June 28th last, in which you set forth a resolution passed by the Executive Committee of the Graduates' Society on June 20th. This resolution was placed before the Board and was sympathetically considered. While the Board will always gladly receive and consider any representations made by the appropriate officers of the Graduates' Society, and while it will always sympathe tically consider claims of graduates of McGill University upon any positions within its gift, the Board holds that it must, if it is to discharge faithfully its trust, place the interests of the University first. It cannot agree to a policy which would confine the list of applicants for any position to those only who are graduates. In academic positions particularly, such a policy is bound to result in in-breeding, and would prejudice the best interests of the University. AWC: DM Aug.29, 1932.
