- 4. No work of Art which has been publicly exhibited in the city in which the Exhibition for the year is held shall be admitted.
- 5. Not more than ten pictures shall be received from each Academician or Associate to be hung for sale in the Exhibition: and not more than four pictures shall be exhibited for any Artist who is not a member of the Canadian Academy. All works marked for sale in the Catalogue must be the work of the Exhibitor and the property of the Exhibitor.
- 6. No Picture shall be received without a gilt frame.
- 7. No work intended for exhibition shall be received after the time limited for the reception has expired.
- 8. Descriptions of works sent for the Exhibition to be as short as possible and all unnecessary quotations to be condensed at the discretion of the Council.
- 9. As soon as the time limited for sending to the Canadian Academy works of Art for Exhi-
