A By-law to authorize the Treasurer to pay the Salary of the High Constable of the County of York.

**WHEREAS**, in pursuance of the power vested in them by the 23rd Vic., cap. 8, as amended by the 24th Vic., cap. 48, the magistrates of the County of York, in adjourned Sessions assembled, did, on the 26th day of March, 1872, appoint John T. Jones High Constable for the said County, in the place of Wm. Higgins, deceased, accompanied by a recommendation to pay him a certain sum per annum for his services;

Be it therefore enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the County of York, that the Treasurer of the County be and he is hereby authorized to pay to the said High Constable the sum of six hundred dollars per annum in equal monthly instalments as the said salary becomes due, said salary to be computed from the first day of January, 1883.

And be it further enacted that By-laws Nos. 221 and 319, be and the same are hereby repealed.
