They have built another Fort at the Forks, where the River Oubasche falls into the River Ohio. How many more Fortresses they have erected lower down towards the River Missippi, and on that River, I do not pretend to know. They have likewise built two Vessels like our Brigantines, of about 60 or 70 Tons for Transportation on the Lake Outario. These Lakes are large Inland Seas, navigable by Vessels of a considerable Burthen.

By the Treaty of Utrecht, confirmed by the Treaty of Aix-la-Chapelle, it is expresly stipulated that the French shall have Liberty of passing into the Country of the Five Nations, and other Indians in Friendship with Great-Britain, for the sake of Commerce; and that the English shall have the same Liberty of passing into the Countries of the Indians in Friendship with the French on the same Purpose.

Since the last Treaty, the French have plundered several of his Majesty's Subjects trading, not in the Countries of the Indians in Friendship with the French, but in the Countries of the Iroquois, and other Indian Nations in Friendship with Great-Britain, of Goods to a very great Value; killed some, made others Prisoners, and transported several to Old-France. They have lately
