every two months, at the rates mentioned in Scale No. 3. These accounts to be accompanied by 2 certificate on each, from the commanding-officer of the corps, or detachment, in whole use it has been, that it was returned dirty into ftore, which will be a sufficient voucher, to authorise the washing. These accounts to be also certified by the Barrack-Master. It must be remembered, that fheets are always paid for by the troops, and never brought into the accounts with the other bedding. On the delivery of clean fheets to a corps, or detachment, the Barrack-Master is to make application to the Quarter-Master of such corps or detachment, or perfon acting as fuch, for payment for the washing thereof, at the rate of three pence half penny per pair, for every pair fo No bedding that has been in use of one iffued. corps, or detachment, can be issued to another, without previously being washed. The bedding is to be exchanged, according to the periods marked in Scale No. 4 and 5, and no corps or detachment can be allowed to have it exchanged oftener, a unlefs a fpecial authority is isfued for that pur-2 pofe, by the officer commanding at the Poft where C fuch exchange may be found necessary : which r authority must be forwarded with the certificates, and accounts for washing the fame : and it is (the particular duty of the Barrack-Mafter to fee f that the bedding is exchanged at the proper periods, C
