The charter fee is only \$15, and the charter will issue in a few days. The company them meets, and all the shares are handed over to the vendor of the mining claim as fully paid-up stock, in lieu of his title, claim or rights. The vendor then donates all the shares, except such portion as he may desire to retain, back to the company. A certain number is given back for the benefit of the treasury, called treasury stock, to be sold for developing the mine. The remainder is given to the promoters as their interests may appear, in return for a personal consideration, which is the price paid by them for the claim. This stock is commonly called promoters' stock, and is identical with the treasury stock, except that any money paid for it does not go into development work. The promoters usually agree and should agree to pool their interests until the treasury stock is sold, or agree not to sell at less than the treasury price. Otherwise the stock will be on the market at two prices, the promoters' stock underselling the treasury stock.


