C.P.R. HAS ADVANCED HUNDRED MILLIONS TO WINNING OF WAR

Over Ten Thousand Employees Gone Overseas.

TEN STEAMERS ARE LOST Part Taken by Two Steamers as Cruisers Makes Thrilling Reading.

THOROLD, Feb. 3.—The romantic war tale of two well-known Canadian steamers, the Empress of Russia and the Empress of Asia, was related by President Beatty of the Canadian Pacific Railway at a banquet given in his honor by the local board of trade to-night.

In giving a sketch of the war work of the C. P. R. Mr. Beatty said the Empress of Russia was turned into an auxiliary cruiser for patrol work in the Indian Ocean. Her first work was to pick up the cruiser Sydney after that ship had made a mass of tangled wreckage of the roving Emden, had taken off the Emden's crew, including the captain, the redoubtable von Mueller, and carried them to Colombo, Ceylon.
