All the necessary forms were gone through, confirming and giving effect to the Resolution passed at the Annual Meeting on the 6th March, authorising the Temporal Committee to borrow \$15,000 for ten years, at a rate of interest not greater than eight per cent., on mortgage of the Church property, for the purpose of erecting a new place of Worship. It was understood that the money referred to in the preceding Resolution be not borrowed until the subscription list shall first have reached the amount of, at least, Twenty Thousand Dollars.

It was resolved that a statement of the proceedings at the Annual Meeting of the Congregation, and at this Special General Meeting, be embodied in the Annual Report of the Congregation.
