### DECIDES AGAINST EARLY FERRY TRIP

Council Defeats Proposal—  
Increase for Lancaster  
Service Passed.

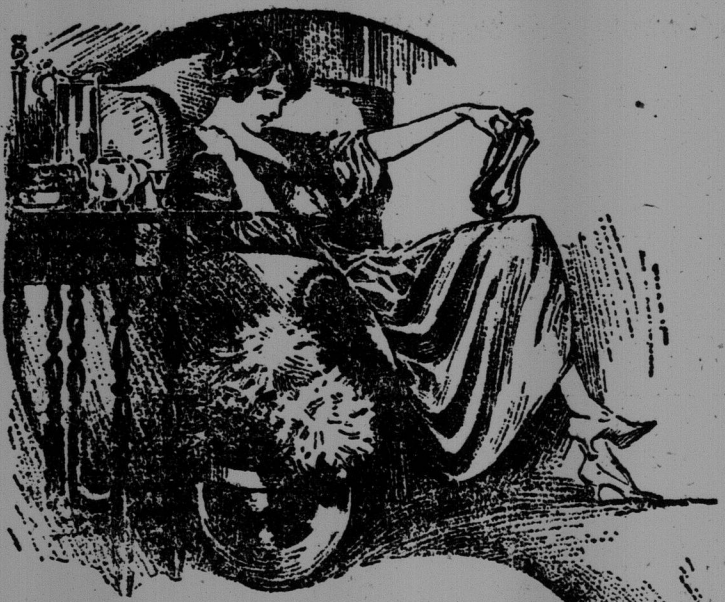
Commissioner Bullock at yesterday afternoon's meeting of the City Council reported against running an early trip of the ferry during the winter months and requested that New Brunswick Power Co. would run two early cars from West Side to the city and north end. The report of G. G. Harve, city engineer, on the Spruce Lake water main was received and filed. It was decided to ask for more information from G. G. Harve as to when additional sheets of the city survey would be ready before taking any further action in this matter.

The report of the committee of the whole recommending, among other things, the sum for the Lancaster and hallowtown ferry be increased from \$2,500 to \$2,800, was adopted. Spruce Lake Main.

Commissioner Wigmore presented the report of the city engineer on the Spruce Lake water main. The engineer said the leak in the pipe was caused by shock due to the sudden turning on of the water and that cast iron pipe would have suffered much more severely under the same conditions and probably have been put out of commission altogether. He thought that water hammering had been caused while repairs were being made were more than offset by the nine months' use of the pipe before the contractors had to turn it over to the city. The repair to the pipe had been made at the expense of the contractor and a good job had been done, 2,880 feet having been laid. The report was received and filed.

A communication from J. E. Kane that he had been refused permission to build a building on the rear of his lot, 251 Charlotte street, to the front of the lot on the advice of the city solicitor was referred to the Commissioner of Public Safety and city solicitor for a report. Mayor Fisher said he had looked into this matter and the city solicitor had pointed out to him the action under which his ruling was made.

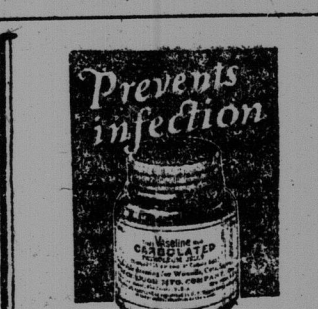

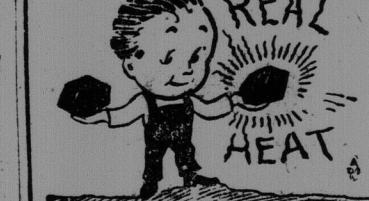
**BOSTON HAD SNOW.**
