### COMMERCIAL CLUB PROTEST AGAINST PROPOSED CHANGE

In regard to the matter of removing  
the headquarters of the post office from  
spectors and railway mail service to  
Hon. H. R. McLellan, secretary of  
the Commercial Club, has not allowed the  
club to be classed as an "also ran" but  
immediately got busy and made a vigor-  
ous protest to those in authority in  
Ottawa against the removal of these  
services from St. John. Mr. McLellan,  
on March 11, sent a telegram to Hon. R.  
W. Higgins, S. E. Elkin, M. P., R. L.  
Hon. A. W. McElgin, Hon. P. E. Blos-  
din and Senator Fowler, to the effect  
that word had been received that the  
headquarters of the post office inspectors  
and railway mail clerks for New Brun-  
swick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward  
Island were to be amalgamated and re-  
moved to Montreal and telling of the loss  
to St. John such a move would be. The  
telegram requested that the headquarters  
be kept in St. John.
