## CANADIAN PRODUCE MARKETS

Special to The Standard.

Toronto, Sept. 2.—The local requirements of new wheat are still far greater than the supply and prices are very firm. Dealers are prepared to pay within a couple of cents of a dollar for wheat in response to the movement in foreign markets the quotation on corn has advanced a cent, but it is believed that the advance is more than temporary.

Ontario wheat—No. 2 new winter wheat, 96 cents to 98 cents outside.

Manitoba wheat—No. 1 northern, \$1.20 to \$1.21 nominal on track at lake ports; No. 1 northern new wheat for Ontario oats for first shipment 35 cts. lake ports.

Oats—No. 2 white, 47 cents to 47 1/2 cents on track at Toronto; No. 2 white, 45 cents; Canada western No. 2, 43 1/2 cents; No. 1 extra feed, 43 cents; No. 2, 42 1/2 cents lake ports, 46 cents to 47 cents on track at Toronto. New Ontario oats for first shipment 35 cts. lake ports.

Manitoba flour—Quotations at Toronto are: First patents, \$5.80; second, \$5.70; strong bakers, \$5.10. For export of 90 per cent. patents, 31s Glasgow freight.

Ontario flour—New winter wheat patents at \$4 to \$4.10 in buyers bag on track at Toronto. New wheat flour for export, \$3.90 to \$4 outside in buyers sacks.

Mellified—Manitoba bran, \$21 to \$21.50 per ton; shorts, \$22 to \$24 on track at Toronto; New wheat flour, \$22, shorts, \$24 on track at Toronto.

Receipts of eggs today were 1096 compared with 613 for the corresponding date last year. There is a good demand on local account but owing to the high prices ruling business for export has been very light. The market is firm. Selected stock, 23 1/2 cents to 26 cents; No. 2 candied, 22 1/2 cents to 23 cents and No. 2, 16 to 19 cents per dozen. Receipts of butter today were 4173 packages against 4528 for the corresponding date of last year. The market is steady under a fairly good demand with finest creamery at 23 cents.

There is a good demand for baled hay. Prices are firm. Choice No. 1 hay, \$11 to \$12; extra No. 2 \$10.50 to \$11; No. 3 hay, \$10 to \$10.50; clover mixed, \$9.50 to \$10; clover, \$8.50 to \$9.
