Beauty Secrets for the
Physical Culture Girl

MOUNTAIN CLIMBING, INDOOR TENNIS, SKIPPING THE ROPE, AND
THE DRY SWIM.

The physical culture professor was
pounding the starch out of a patient
when a reporter rushed in and called
him off. Of course the reporter got
the thanks of the victim.

"Nutsy," said the professor, "I
want to know all about this physical
culture game."
"Skip the rope, that's the secret. Get
back to your childhood days, and play
just like you did as a child and you
will be young and shapely again. But
there is a right and a wrong way to
skip the rope, and I get paid for tel-
ling them how."

"Now, when you do your skipping,
give your arms a full swing, round
and round. Don't jump up and down
on one place, but move the rope by
moving the arms only from the elbow.
Bring the muscles of the upper arms
into play. That brings out the chest
and develops the bust. Another thing,
don't jump up and down on both feet
at once. That over-
taxes the heart. Jump first on one
foot then on the other, using a run-
ning skip. Keep it up as long as you
can; it isn't a tiresome exercise."

Mountain climbing is another good
exercise, the professor says. He rests
the end of a board on a chair, at an
inclination, and the patients walk the
plank up and down. You can do it at
home just as well. The exercise of
balancing with both arms extended is
good, and the walking rounds out the
legs and strengthens the ankles.

And then, too, every girl can swim
at home—dry swim. All that is neces-
sary is to lie on the stomach across
a chair and move the arms and kick
the feet as you would in swimming.
Also, it will help you to learn the real
thing in the swimming luge, if you
don't know how already.

The indoor tennis game is a dandy
good exercise. The professor has a
rubber ball suspended from the ceiling
by a stout string, and his patients
put this about with a tennis racket;
a wicker carpet beater would do as
well. The patient gets almost as much
exercise jumping around in this way
as she would in a game of tennis.
These are the secrets of the profes-
sor, secrets no longer. Try 'em at
home and help starve the professor.

FIRST BLOW KILLS BOY IN

COMRADES' "HONOR" FIGHT

They Opened the Coronation
Meeting Yesterday—Several
of His Majesty's Horses
Entered.

London, June 12.—King George and
the Queen drove in state to Ascot to
attend and opened the coronation meet-
ing.

Windsor Castle is so full of guests
that the Prince of Wales, Princess
Mary and Prince George are stop-
ping at Frogmore House. Every
house in the neighborhood of Ascot
is taken. Hotel accommodation is un-
obtainable. The supply of tickets to
the royal enclosure was exhausted a
week ago. The display of dresses and
millinery was the most beautiful in
the history of fashions on racecourses.

King George will see many of his
horses in the course of the four
days' meeting, but the experts do not
fancy any of them except Windansea
which is said to have a chance to win
the Eboracshire Stakes today, although
Lord Rosebery's Clodius will be the
favorite.

Among those present today besides
the King's Windsor guests were the
colonial statesmen and their wives,
and many distinguished persons from
Canada and overseas dominions.

Never has Ascot looked better than
today. The royal enclosure is in eight
landscapes, each drawn by four boys,
while three landscapes drawn by pairs
carried the suites. Accompanied by
mounted equestrians the procession pro-
ceeded slowly from Windsor Castle to
Ascot Heath, and thence along the
course to the Royal enclosure to cheer-
ing and the waving of handker-
chiefs.

It is the strict rule of their Maj-
esties that the Royal enclosure must
be crowded and accordingly Lord
Chambourlain the Earl of Shaftesbury
was obliged to refuse thousands of
applications for admission to the place.
