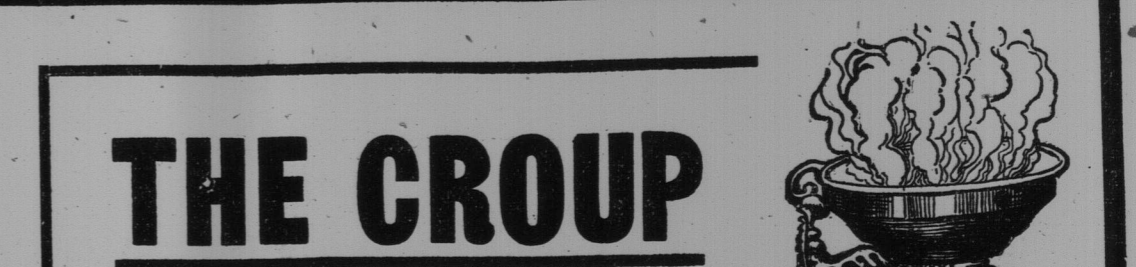

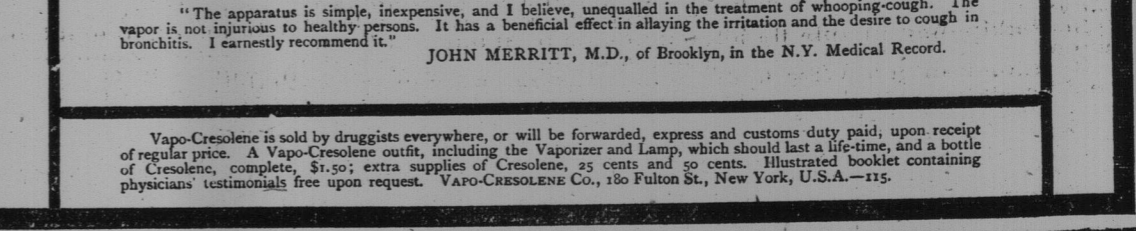
Cholera in the Philippines.
