S. of Owen Owens, of Denbigh, Wales, and Charlotte Lindley, of Brantford, Eng. B. at Stonefield, Co. of Argenteuil, 15 May, 1840. M., Sept., 1890, Margaret, second dau. of John McMartin, Chicago, formerly of Montreal. Is a Lieut. in the Active Militia. Has been Postmaster, Councillor, and Mayor of the Township of Chatham. Sat in the Leg. Assembly of Quebec from g. e., 1881 to 1891. Called to the Senate, 2 Jan., 1896. A Conservative.—4031 *Dorchester St., Montreal.*

PELLETIER, *Hon.* CHARLES ALPHONSE PANTALEON, C.M.G., B.C.L., Q.C., P.C. (*Grandville*).

S. of J. M. Pelletier, by Julie Painchaud, sister of the late Rev. C. F. Painchaud, founder of the Coll. of St. Anne, P.Q. B. at River Ouelle, P.Q., 22 Jan., 1837. Ed. at St. Anne's Coll. and at Laval Univ., from which he obtained degree of B.C.L., 15 Sept., 1858. M., 1st, 1861, Susanne, dau. of the late Hon. Charles E. Casgrain, M.L.C. (she d. 1862) ; 2nd, Virginia A., second dau. of the late Hon. M. P. DeSales La Terriere, M.D., who sat in the Parlt. of L.C., and afterwards in that of United Can. Called to the Bar, L.C., 1860. Apptd. Q.C. by the Govt. of Quebec, 21 Jan., 1879. Has been Syndic and the Batonnier of the Quebec Bar, and was elected three times Presdt. of the Soc. de St. Jean Baptiste, Quebec. Is a dir. of the Quebec Fire Assur. Co. Was for several years Major 9th Batt., or Voltigeurs de Quebec. Was in command of that batt. during the Fenian raid of 1866; retired, retaining his rank, in Sept., 1866. Was a candidate for Kamouraska at g. e., 1867, when
