An Act to legalize certain By-laws of the Municipality of the County of Middlesex.

HEREAS through mere inadvertence the corporate or common Preamble. seal of the Municipality has not been attached to certain Bylaws passed at different times by the Municipal Council of the United Counties of Middlesex and Elgin, and by the Municipal Council of the 5 County of Middlesex; And whereas it is expedient to remove all doubts which might arise as to the legality of the said By-laws, owing to the absence of the said seal; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The following By-laws, to wit:

sex on the eleventh day of March, 1854."
