vacancies as hereinbefore provided, and generally to perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board in a By-law for regulating his office.

XII. It shall be the duty of the said Board of Governors, to invest in Governors to 5 good, safe and sufficient securities, all moneys which may at any time invest Hospicome into their hands, for the use and support of the said Hospital, which may not be required for the immediate expenditure of the same; and from time to time, when required so to do by the Governor of this Province, to To account to render an account in detail of all moneys received by them as Gover. Governor of 10 nors of the said Hospital, specifying the sources from which the same have arisen or been received, and the manner in which the same have been invested or expended, and all such particulars as may be necessary to shew the state of the funds or endowment, if any, of the said Hospital; and the Reports to said Board of Governors shall also lay an annual statement of their affairs Legislature. 15 before both Houses of the Legislature, within thirty days after the commencement of each session.

XIII. The said Board of Governors, by the corporate name aforesaid, Additional shall have, in addition to the powers conferred by the "Interpretation Act" powers to aforesaid, power to distrain for any rent or rents of any lands or buildings, ernora. 20 or any account whatever, and to distrain for rents when the same are in arrear and unpaid, and to act in all matters touching the collection and control of the funds of the said Hospital, and the management and disposition of any lands belonging to the same, as shall appear to them to be most conducive to the interest of the said Hospital.

25 XIV. It shall and may be lawful for any Medical Student in the said Medical stu-City of Kingston to visit the wards of the said Hospital and attend them, dents may viupon the payment of such fees, and under such regulations and instructions tel. as the said Board of Governors shall and may by any By-law from time to time direct and appoint, and with the sanction of the attending Medical 30 Officers.

XV. Neither the repeal of the Act hereinbefore repealed, nor the change Existing conhereby made in the corporate name of or in the composition of the Cor. tracts not afporation thereby constituted and hereby continued, shall in any wise affect fected. contracts or any proceedings heretofore bona fide made or had pursuant 35 to the provisions of the said Act, or any other Act relating to the said Hospital.

XVI. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.

XVII. The Interpretation Act shall apply to this Act except wherever Interpretathe provisions of this Act are inconsistent therewith. tion_
