BILL.

An Act to incorporate *The Provincial Mutual and General Insurance Company*:-

WHEREAS Robert Easton Burns, Joseph Preamble
C. Morrison, Richard C. Gapper,
Henry Rowsell, James Browne. Duncan
McDonell, Esquires, and others, have peti-
5 tioned the Legislature, praying that an Asso-
ciation under the style and title of "*The*
Provincial Mutual and General Insur-
ance Company," may be incorporated as
well for the purpose of enabling parties,
10 owners of or interested in property situated
in country places and comparatively safe
from fire, mutually to insure each other, as
also the better to enable such institution to
conduct and extend the business of Fire,
15 Marine and Life Assurance, and for grant-
ing Annuities and sums of money payable
at future periods within Her Majesty's Do-
minions in North America, and other places
abroad ; And whereas it hath been consider-
20 ed that it would in many respects be greatly
advantageous if such Corporation were es-
tablished. Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority
of the same; That all such persons as now
25 are or hereafter shall become members of
the said Company, shall be hereby ordained,
constituted and declared to be a body cor-
porate and politic in law, in fact and in
name, by the style and title of *The Provin-*
30 *cial Mutual and General Insurance Company*,
and by that name, style and title they and
their successors shall and may have conti-
ed succession, and shall be capable in law of
suing and being sued, pleading and being
35 impleaded, answering and being answered
