

An Act respecting the Canada Southern Bridge Company.

WHEREAS the Canada Southern Bridge Company has, by Preamble.
its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 2 of chapter 63 of the statutes of 1877 is hereby repealed, and the power of the Canada Southern Bridge Company to construct, maintain, work and manage a railway bridge across the Detroit River for railway purposes, from some point in or near the town of Amherstburg, in the county of Essex, towards the island of Grosse Isle, in the State of Michigan, in the United States, is hereby revived, confirmed and authorized. 1877, c. 63, s. 2 repealed. Power to construct bridge over Detroit river.
2. The times limited by the Acts respecting the said company for the completion of its undertaking are hereby extended as follows: The works authorized by the Acts relating to the said company shall be completed within ten years from the passing of this Act, otherwise the powers granted to the said company by the said Acts shall cease and be null and void. Time for completion of works extended.
