

Cricketbank, who was then living upon the said Lot, as deponent's Tenant, for certain Notes of hand given by one Nathaniel Miller to this deponent for the sum of twenty five pounds. from the proceeds of which the said John Taylor agreed to pay any balance that might be found to be due by this deponent as Collector as aforesaid - that the said Taylor procured the said Notes, but did not apply them as agreed upon. and that this deponent had to devote a pension of twenty pounds per annum, which he then had and still holds for payment of the said balance, and that the three years of said pension were applied for that purpose: - That by the said deed in this deponent also conveyed to the said Taylor upon the consideration aforesaid, his this deponent's interest in lot number twenty eight in the first Concession of the said Township of Thurlow, which said interest some time after this deponent's discharge from imprisonment, together with certain cattle belonging to this deponent, were sold by the Deputy Sheriff of the District upon an execution against this deponent, when the said Taylor became the purchaser thereof at a very low price upon a private understanding that it should be for the use of this deponent, which arrangement was afterwards repudiated by the said Taylor and this deponent had not means to enter into a contest with him to enforce its fulfilment.

That upon this deponent's discharge from Gaol in September A.D. 1827, he this deponent returned to the said Broken Front and continued to reside there until the twelfth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two, when he obtained a Lease therefrom from the Mississauga Indians, at a rent of two pounds per annum, which rent this deponent paid for three years, and remained in possession until the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five, when the said John Taylor forcibly ejected him therefrom.

This deponent further said that during the continuance of his possession as aforesaid, from A.D. 1816: to A.D. 1835, he built a frame barn a log house, and cleared about ten acres upon
