With reference to yours of the 10th instant in regard to plans covering survey of the Grand Trunk Pacific Branch Lines Company on the above line, I note that you have found certain discrepancies between this plan and plan on which the Company's right of way was based at the time patent was issued. This is quite right, and the plans which are at present before you were prepared for the express purpose of having these discrepancies cleared up. Under the agreement, however, which the Company have with the Province of Saskatchewan after the registration of these new plans the Company are bound to have every existing title corrected to refer to the new plan, and under the circumstances, your records will be adjusted as soon as the plan has been filed.

With this explanation I trust that you will see your way clear to have the tracings duly signed and returned to me.
