Page 8, Clause 14, strike out all the words between "respect", in line 21, and "of" in line 23.

Sub-clause 1, of Clause 14, amended as proposed would read as follows:-

"14. The Trustees shall make a report annually to Parliament setting forth in a summary manner the results of their operations, any co-operative measures, plans or arrangements effected pursuant to this Act, any economies or more remunerative operation thereby produced, the amounts expended on capital account in respect of National Railways and such other information as appears to them to be of public interest or necessary for the information of Parliament with relation to any situation existing at the time of such report, or as may be required from time to time by the governor in Council."
