

NOW THEREFORE it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. Whenever used in this agreement or any schedule thereof the word "Minister" shall mean the Minister of Labour for Canada and the term "material aid" shall mean either food, fuel, clothing and shelter (or any of them) supplied to individuals in necessitous circumstances, or, the costs of carrying on works and training projects specifically designated by the Province as projects intended to provide said individuals when employed thereon (other than supervisory personnel) the equivalent of food, fuel, clothing and shelter (or any of them) which otherwise, would have to be supplied to those individuals, provided in each case that a schedule setting forth a description of the project, the estimated total cost thereof and the specific costs to which the Dominion will contribute has been approved in writing by the Minister.

2. Subject to fulfilment by the Province of the provisions of this Agreement in a manner satisfactory to the Minister, the Dominion will pay to the Province for each of the months of April 1938 to December 1938 inclusive, a grant-in-aid, not exceeding Two hundred and thirty thousand dollars (\$230,000.00) in respect of the total expenditures incurred by the Province and its municipalities for material aid supplied during each of said months to individuals in necessitous circumstances, or, in the alternative, will pay 35% of said expenditures if the latter amount is the lesser, provided however, that after the month of September 1938 the amount of said grant may be subject to revision by the Dominion from time to time, any revision so made to be set by a Dominion Order in Council.

3. For its own purposes and for the purposes of the National Registration the Province undertakes on its own behalf and on behalf of its municipalities, to segregate and identify
