Referring to your letter of the 20th instant, and to the atter from Mr. Agent Lomas of the 9th instant, which accomplied it having further reference to the proposed "paying off" gathering to be held at Cowichan by Chief Klenawalt, I beg to inform you that having submitted Mr. Lomas' letter to the Superintendent General I am i structed to say that while Mr. Lomas should in no ay whatever encourage, or sanction the proposed celebratis, he need not take any measures to prevent the sarr, un ess complaint is made in a formal manner before him by some party, or parties to the effect that some Indian or Indians are celebrating the "potlach". You will recomber that the enforcement of the law for the prevention of such feasts, or celebration rests with the authorities of the local Government and not with the Indian Agent, before whom however any parties accused. of engaging in , or encouraging the celebration of the same ry be prosecuted.
