



Ottawa, February 9, 1911.

Rev. Sir,

Referring to your recent conversation with the Superintendent of Indian Education in which you brought up the matter of repairs to the Alberni Boarding School, B. C.; I beg to say that this matter has been given consideration and, in view of the contributions which have been made by the Department towards the upkeep of this building, as outlined in letters to you of November 11, 1909, and January 8, 1910, it is thought that the Presbyterian Church should undertake the necessary expenditure to entitle the school to draw the increased grant provided for under the new contract which will come into effect on April 1st. next.
