

officer of the Canadian Army Overseas, having
been duly sworn, states:

I am the Assistant Adjutant of No.1 Canadian
General Reinforcement Unit. I produce a
certified copy of the Declaration of a Court
of Inquiry referring to B.73846, Pte. Lee, M.N.
and concerns his absence without leave (admitted
as evidence and marked as Exhibit "A") I also
produce a Certificate of apprehension referring
to the said Pte. Lee, signed by an officer of
the Canadian Provost Corps. I do not know the
accused.

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.






C.5573, L/Cpl. Ray, S.F., No.1 Canadian General
