Brankap & Character Witness Lieut W.D. Blackburn, Seaforth of C. I have known Pte White for over a year. In all that time I have found him a very hard and cheerful worker. At any time Pte White did anything I asked him to do and did it well. Questions by Defence Do you want Pte White back in your Pl? Has he ever been muilty of any offence against good soldiering, other than absent without leave? A Are you acquainted with his family misfortunes? I understand that there were a number of deaths in his family some time ago. Apart from that I know nothing. Questions by Prosecutor Are you suggesting that these are responsible for his absence? No. Statement in Mitigation of Punishment Will you tell the Court about your family bereavements?
In March I received word that I had a baby daughter. In
May I received a telegram telling me she had died. In
between that time my mother through adoption passed away.
She was my natural grandmother. Just recently I had a
letter from home saying my wife's grandmother had passed AWBY. Was that March and May 1941? Yes. Have you ever been up on a charge of any other offences, other than absent without leave?
Yes. On a charge of being improperly dressed. I was Q admonished. Have you taken part in sports for this Battalion? Yes. Also for Division. Will you show the Court medals you have won in Sports? Two. (1 Cdn Div Track Medals were produced to the Court.) When were you placed under arrest on this charge? 16th October 1941. Did you ask for a Court Martial? No. When was a copy of the Charge Sheet delivered to you? 5 November 1941.
