Sir,

I beg to report that at 10.25 hrs. on Wednesday, 11th March, 1942, I was on duty at Midhurst Police Station, when the above named soldier surrendered to me, stating that he had something which had been worrying him, and he felt that he must give himself up. I asked him what it was, and he replied, "About 10 days ago I broke open a meter at Midhurst and took 21/- from it. He gave the address of the house no 59, Roberts Road, Alderholt, and occupied by a Mrs. Wirling.

I telephoned to Alderholt Police, after which he was detained at Midhurst Police Station until 0055 on the following day when he was taken into custody by the Alderholt Police.
