 Gneiss sedimentary invaded by much granite.

 Conglomerate, sandstone and arkose.

 Claystones (often siliceous and calcareous with admixture of volcanic material).

 Amphibolite and gneiss bands.

 Gneissic granite with many amphibolite inclusions.
