

NOTES

The Carnegie Public Library is situated on the corner of Yates and Blanshard Streets.

The principal streets are Government and Douglas Streets, running North and South; Fort, Yates, View, Johnson and Pandora Streets, running East and West.

The Street Railway System of the City centres in the district bounded and intersected by the thoroughfares described above, and cars may be boarded at the intersection of any of these streets.

The depot of the B.C.E.R. Saanich Interurban Line is at 1505 Douglas Street, opposite City Hall.

The Esquimalt and Nanaimo (C.P.R.) Railway Station is on Store Street, at the foot of Cormorant Street.
