38. Upon the demand of any candidate, or his duly Oath may be authorized agent, or any duly qualified elector in the demanded said city, the returning officer shall administer to any of voter. voter the oath (in the form hereunto annexed): if the voter refuse to take the said oath, the word "refused" shall be written opposite his name, and he shall not be allowed to vote; if the voter take the oath, the word "sworn" shall be written opposite his name, and his name, and his vote shall be received and registered.

39. In the event of the decease, or absence from what? in illness or otherwise, of any returning officer or poll case of afclerk appointed as aforesaid, or his refusal to act, power turning offiis given to the city clerk to appoint a substitute to per-cer or poll form the duties of the returning officer or poll clerk so elerk. absent.
