SYNOPSIS OF DOMINION LAND REGULATIONS

Any person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 16 years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother, or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother, or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may prevent a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price, \$13.00 per acre.

Duties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homesteaded entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price, \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house, worth \$20.00.
