An ACT in addition to an Act, intituled
an Act for the further increase of the
Revenue of the Province.

Passed the 29th of March 1820.

WHEREAS in and by an Act made Preamble.
and passed in the sixtieth year of
His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for
the further increase of the Revenue of the
Province," it is among other things enacted,
that a duty of seven shillings and sixpence
per ton, be paid upon all Plaster of Paris
imported or brought into the County of
Charlotte. *And whereas* it is deemed expedient
to extend the provisions of the said Act,

I: *Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly,* That from
and after the passing of this Act, a like duty
of seven shillings and sixpence per ton, as
is imposed in and by the herein before recited
Act, in the County of Charlotte aforesaid,
be also imposed and paid upon all Plaster of
Paris imported or brought into the harbour
of the City of Saint John; which duty of
seven shillings and sixpence per ton shall be
paid as in the next succeeding section of this
Act is required, by the master, owner, or
consignee, of any ship or vessel so arriving
in the harbour of Saint John aforesaid; before
bulk is broken, and within twenty-four
hours after the arrival of such ship or vessel
as aforesaid.

A Duty of 7s. 6d.

II. *And be it further enacted,* That for the
better securing and carrying into effect the
provisions of this Act, it shall be the duty of
the Preventive Officer appointed, or to be
appointed by virtue of the herein before re-
cited

The Preventive
Officer to appoint
a Deputy.
